Topic: Uranium Poisoning in International Water Supplies by Terrorists

Report of the Chairs

I. Theme of the Conference

II. Rationale

Recent tests of water across the globe have shown alarming quantities of Uranium present in water intended for human use and consumption. As of now, the countries with confirmed tests include the United States, Russia, France, Canada, and Germany, but all countries should be wary as one contaminated water source can affect a whole region. The extremity of this event and the un-natural cause of the contamination heavily suggest that a terrorist group is behind it because of its framing as a direct attack on the countries affected. The purchase of Uranium by this emerging group proves the suspicion of an underground trade of Uranium. Delegates should strive to collaborate to create lasting solutions to this crisis and to foresee a future in which the threat of such a crisis has been mitigated.

III. Crisis Description

In the past year, two-hundred million European civilians have been affected, and Uranium indicators around the world have been set-off. Uranium in European water systems has had detrimental effects on the people, with many showing signs of organ failure and the risk of cancer^{1,3}. We suspect the terrorists accused of the attacks do not have a license for the use and

control of Uranium, and as of now, we do not know their motivation to commit such a heinous act. We fear they will poison additional international water systems potentially in the same or other countries.

The investigation to find the terrorists has had little success, and the evidence found traces back to companies that globally export Uranium without the mandatory license⁴. Governments across the world have taken no action other than attempting to decontaminate the water², and there hasn't been much development with such because of the sheer danger of approaching the water. Unfortunately, this lack of investigation has not led to the apprehension of those who are responsible and little to no knowledge of their whereabouts or motivations has been gained.

As the delegates come together, they must make sure that everyone in a contaminated area is evacuated safety as well as seeing towards the definite apprehension of the terrorists. They must also look towards the future and focus on the dangers of Uranium and potential preventions for possible future contaminations. World leaders and ranking cabinet members of all delegations should strive to create resolutions for the safety of the people they represent, and for the rest of the world.
